

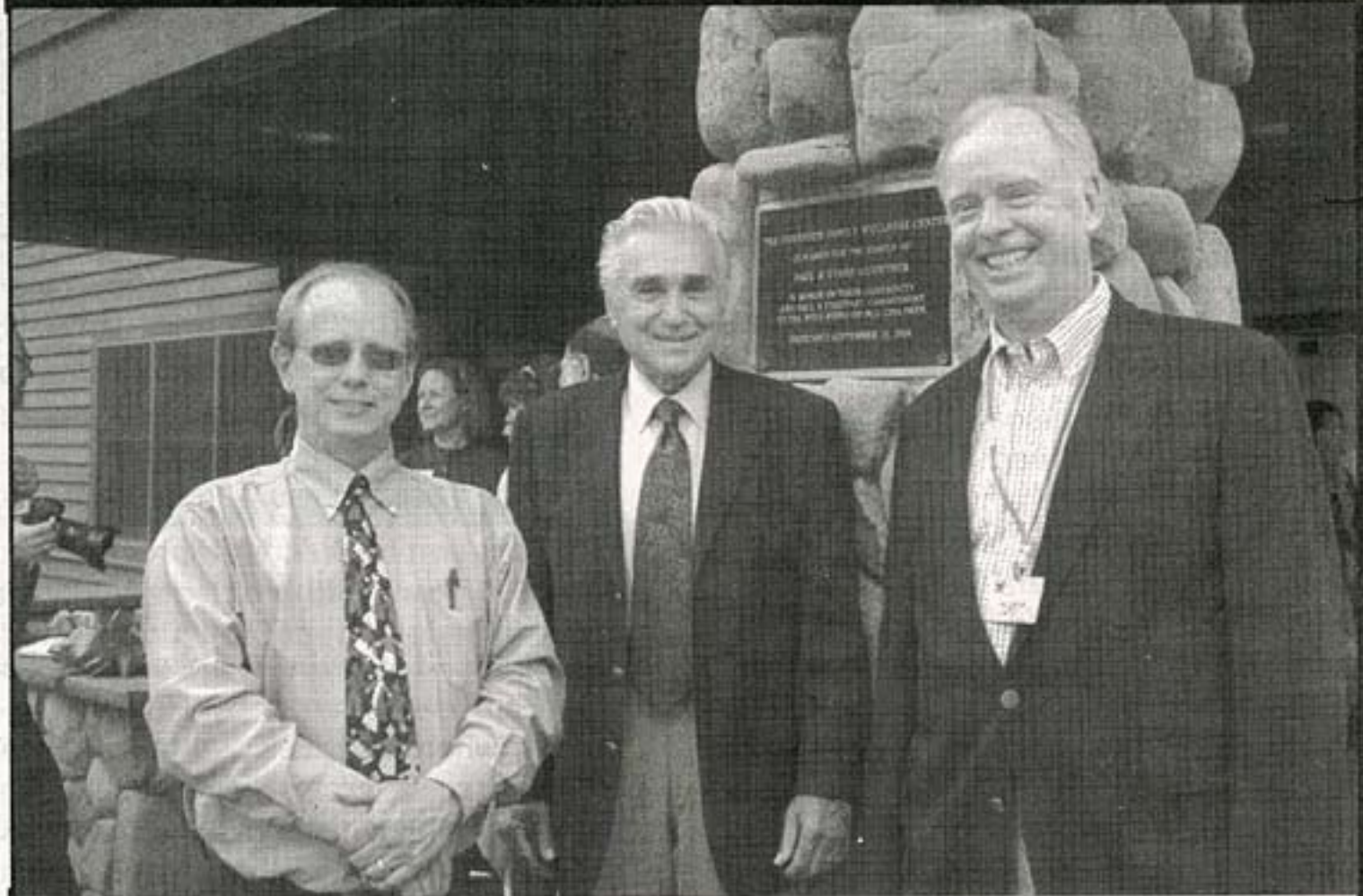

After touring through the new state-of-the-art health facility, local elected officials, V.I.P.'s, and Frost Valley YMCA leadership and staff joined in acknowledging the extraordinary gift of board member Paul Guenther, (Chairman of the New York Philharmonic) whose \$1 million contribution helped make the facility's new Guenther Family Wellness Center, a reality.
