# Adirondack Rambler 1 - Itinerary



<b>Sunday June 27</b>	Participants should arrive at Frost Valley at 2:00 pm. We will spend the rest of the day getting to know each other and checking out gear.
<b>Monday June 28</b>	It will be an early morning as we head for the Adirondacks and Lake Durant Campground. Campsite set up, outdoor cooking, and basic camping etiquette are on the agenda for today.
<b>Tuesday June 29</b>	Today brings us to the Hudson River for a day of whitewater rafting. The Gorge includes one class III rapid and a lot of great class I and II fun. Lake Durant will serve as our home for one more night.
<b>Wednesday June 30</b>	We'll head north today to Saranac Lakes Wild Forest Area for some backcountry canoeing. Basic canoe strokes, rescue techniques, and navigation are on the menu, as well as our first night in a backcountry campsite.
<b>Thursday July 1</b>	Our canoes will carry us (and we'll have to carry our canoes at one point) as we continue to explore the Saranac Lakes area. Tonight we'll stay in another backcountry campsite.
<b>Friday July 2</b>	The canoeing portion of our trip will come to a close at Rollins Pond. We'll spend the night at Sharp Bridge Campground.
<b>Saturday July 3</b>	Today we will be joined by professional guides as we learn the basics of rock climbing in the Adirondacks.
<b>Sunday July 4</b>	This will be our second day of rock climbing and our final night at Sharp Bridge Campground.
<b>Monday July 5</b>	After repacking our gear into day packs, we'll be heading up our first peak for an all day hiking adventure, ending at a campground for the night.*
<b>Tuesday July 6</b>	We'll hike another peak today and enjoy the beautiful Adirondack scenery before returning to our campsite.
<b>Wednesday July 7</b>	Our final day of hiking will bring us to the campsite where we'll wrap up some of our experiences before going to sleep.
<b>Thursday July 8</b>	After breakfast, we'll pack up and head back to Frost Valley to clean up gear and share some of our favorite times.
<b>Friday July 9</b>	Finish gear clean up and head home. Parent pick up time is 11:00 am.
